

Sai: In 1970, only about 30 percent could read or write.

Hiroto: But, in 2018, more than 70 percent could read or write! It improved *by about 40 points between 1970 and 2018. It improved a lot! What happened during these years?

Sai: I'm not sure. A I think he worked in India as a *volunteer before. He may know something about it.

[The next day at school]

Hiroto: Hi, Mr. Brown. Sai and I found an article about the literacy rate in India. There is a big difference between 1970 and 2018. It improved greatly. Do you know why?

Mr. Brown: I know some of the reasons. I went to India to do volunteer work about ten years ago. At that time, in India, there were more illiterate people than now. So, the government and some groups worked hard to improve the *situation.

Sai: What did they do?

Mr. Brown: They did various things. For example, they *built a lot of school buildings because there weren't enough. Also, they *expanded the *school lunch program. Thanks to these efforts, more children can go to school now.

Hiroto: That's very nice!

Mr. Brown: However, in some countries, some people still cannot go to school even if they want to do so.

Hiroto: They cannot do so because such countries don't have enough schools, right?

Mr. Brown: Right. But there are other reasons, too. Some children have to stop going to school to help their parents with their work.

Sai: I guess it's difficult for people who cannot go to school to get some types of jobs because they cannot read or write.

Mr. Brown: That's right. Because of that, some of them cannot earn enough money to live. Also, they cannot read important *explanations about *medications or receive various services in their daily lives. As a result, B.

Hiroto: These are serious problems. If I were illiterate, I couldn't learn many things from books or websites.

Mr. Brown: I'm sure learning things can *lead to a better life and save our lives.

Hiroto: I agree. I can go to school and learn many things now. I'm very sad that it's difficult for people in some countries to do those things.

Sai: I'm sad, too. I'm *thankful that I can enjoy learning many things. I want to study harder and learn more things!
